

Lesson 19: How to Make a Complaint

1. Dialogue

First, repeat after your tutor. Then, practice each role.

Eiji: That's a case of public disturbance due to intoxication. You could file a police report against him. Beth: I don't want him to go to jail, though. He's a good man when he's not drunk.

Eiji: I'll tell you what, Ma'am. The police will give him a visit in his apartment. Thank you for coming to the station.
